## Benchmark Results

### Healthy Growth and Development

**85%** completed child development screenings at recommended intervals

**71%** completed well-child medical visits at recommended age intervals



### Safety in the Home

**98%** of children under age 1 were screened for safe sleep practices

**93%** of guardians received Intimate Partner Violence screening within 6 months of enrollment



### School Readiness

**67%** of families engage in daily literacy activities

**96%** of guardians were asked about behavior concerns at every visit

### Maternal Health and Wellbeing

**89%** of guardians were screened for depression within 3 months of enrollment or delivery



**79%** received postpartum care within 56 days after childbirth
