

FORM 2: PRENATAL BENCHMARK

Timeframe	Data Collection
At each home visit	Prenatal care visit
By 8 weeks postpartum	Postpartum Care visit and Contraception survey
By 3 months postpartum	Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Screen
By 6 weeks postpartum	4Ps
From birth to 6 months postpartum, until weaned	Breastfeeding survey

FORM 2: PRENATAL CARE VISITS

- Ask caregivers about prenatal care visits at each home visit
- Document prenatal care visits between enrollment and delivery
- Document on Child Health Info screen or PVR
- Type = physician
- Reason = prenatal care
- Date = date of visit
- Recommended visits are:
 - weeks 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40

FORM 2: POSTPARTUM CARE VISIT

- Ask caregivers about postpartum care visit at home visits after delivery (goal is by 8 weeks postpartum)
- Document on Caregiver Health Info screen under Medical Visits or on PVR
- Type = physician
- Reason = postpartum care
- Date = date of visit
- Postpartum Care Visit** = A visit between the woman and her health care provider to assess the mother's current physical health, including the status of pregnancy-related conditions like gestational diabetes, screen for postpartum depression, provide counseling on infant care and family planning as well as screening and referrals for the management of chronic conditions. Additionally, a provider may use this opportunity to conduct a breast exam and discuss breastfeeding. The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists recommends that mothers receive a postpartum care visit 4-6 weeks after delivery.

- Ask caregivers about postpartum birth control use at home visits after delivery (goal is by 8 weeks postpartum)
- Document on Caregiver Health Info screen under Contraception Use Survey or on PVR
- Date = date of birth control initiation
- Please avoid using N/A or Unknown

FORM 2: 4PS

- Complete at least once prenatally or before 6 weeks postpartum for women who enroll prenatally or within 6 weeks postpartum. Complete as early in pregnancy as possible.
- Document on Caregiver Assessment screen
- Brief intervention or referral should be completed and documented if indicated



- Document on Child Health Info screen under Breastfeeding Survey or on PVR
