

# SHARE YOUR EXPERTISE AND EXPERIENCE WITH HOME VISITING! NATIONAL PROJECT SEEKS HOME VISITING FAMILY MEMBERS FOR FAMILY REPRESENTATIVE ADVISORY BOARD



The Policy & Research Group (PRG) is looking for individuals to serve as members of our Family Representative Advisory Board for a project called “Assessing and Describing Practice Transitions among Evidence-Based Home-Visiting Programs in Response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency” (ADAPT-HV).

ADAPT-HV is created by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) in conjunction with The Administration for Children and Families (ACF) and operated by PRG and Mathematica.

## WHAT IS ADAPT-HV?

Home visiting programs have had to make drastic changes since March 2020. These changes have presented challenges as well as opportunities for innovation in how programs deliver services and engage with families. ADAPT-HV is a 3-year project that will:

- Identify promising practice changes to home visiting that emerged in response to COVID-19.
- Conduct short research studies to understand how these practices can be carried out at larger scales and in different contexts.
- Share findings and develop plans for more in-depth research.

## WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE FAMILY REPRESENTATIVE ADVISORY BOARD?

The Family Representative Advisory Board will provide important insights to help guide the ADAPT-HV research team. Specifically, the Advisory Board will be asked for thoughts on different types of practice changes, and about the perceived benefits, burden, and impact of these changes on families who receive home visiting services.

ADAPT-HV is seeking the expertise of family members who have been involved in home visiting for at least 12 months and can provide feedback based on their experiences. You do not need to have experience with any specific changes in order to participate in the advisory board.

### *MEMBERS OF THE BOARD CAN EXPECT:*

- To commit to serving on the advisory board for at least one year (Feb. 2023 – Dec. 2023). You may re-evaluate your commitment each year.
- To engage with the board for up to five hours over the course of each year.
- We will communicate through email, text, or phone calls, depending on what is easiest for board members.
- We will have virtual listening sessions with the entire board through Zoom to gather feedback on guided questions at each stage in the project. Listening sessions will be approximately one hour.
- All board members will receive an honorarium of \$250 per year, for their participation on the board.
